The camp will take place in Klingberg near Scharbeutz (at the Baltic Sea) from 5th to 17th August 2018. The participants will be hosted in a youth hostel suited for handicapped people. The camp language is English.

The camp is organised by the International Leo Youth Camp e.V. with support of the Leo-Clubs of Northern Germany (District 111-N). Registered charity was founded to realize this camp. The carrying out is honorary.
